




Introduction:



Triathlon – Technical Quiz and Coding competition was organized by PRISMA Club on February 6, 2020. This event was conducted in 3 Rounds.

Tech Electra Club

Under the club 'TECH ELECTRA' various events was organized by the students of electrical engineering department. The aim of the events was to provide students an opportunity to demonstrate their innovative thinking/ skills in the form of quiz, games, entrepreneur ideas, etc. The Events went successful under the visionary leadership of Principal Dr. Manoj Kumar and Head – EE Dr. Sudhir Sharma who addressed the students on various events on the importance of engineering & how Discipline & Positive stress can help in the corporate life. Some major events organized for the students of B. Tech EE in the institute was:

Technical Activities

-  **Virtual Quiz competition** – a technical event consisting of three round namely Knowledge Partner, Component-Dumb-charades and Circuit Developer. In 1st round there are 40 MCQ (technical and aptitude) in which approximately 100 students participated and 40 students shortlisted and in 2nd round, 10 teams of 4 students each participated and the participants have try to tell the component name to his/her partner by dumb charades game. In this only 5 teams qualified in final. And in last round participants have to make circuit on bread-board or on PCB. Winners are awarded with certificates and trophies.
-  **Business Master – a way to Entrepreneur.** – Departmental students organized “BUSINESS MASTER”- a business competition to bring out the new enterprising business and social ideas from the participants having innovative ideas which are technically feasible, commercially viable and socially relevant. To support the selected ideas through nurturing and guidance so that they can be shaped into business start-ups. Dr. Sudhir Sharma (Head – EE) welcomed chief guest of the day Mr. Swarn Kakkar, Director Solar First Energy Pvt. Ltd., Jalandhar. In his motivational speech, he congratulated the students for their effort and also suggested to continue with such type of events that boost the confidence of the students as engineers and to provide opportunity for the participants to bring out their entrepreneurial talents. Many ideas were liked by the guest and the winner was awarded by cash prize of rupees 15000/-
-  **Technician ohm** - is a technical event including word search puzzle related to the electronics and electrical engineering. To make the event interesting there are two more rounds added, the second one includes selecting a chit containing name of a element and participant have to explain about it and in third round he will face a rapid fire phase of quiz. Many students participated in the event to make this event successful. Winners are awarded with goodies bag.
-  **Role Play-** is a technique that allows students to explore realistic situations by interacting with other people in a managed way in order to develop experience and trial different strategies in a supported environment. It is a very flexible teaching approach because it requires no special tools, technology or environments. The students of 7th semester, Electrical Engineering organized role plays for B.Tech. Electrical Engineering 5th and 7th semester students in a seminar hall. Topics for role play were i) System protection and ii) Working of alternator. The basic idea of “System protection” was to show how different types of protective schemes like relays, fuse, circuit breaker etc. are used for protection and also the role of an electrical engineer in clearing the fault. Similarly the basic idea of “Working of alternator” was to show how different parts of alternator like stator, rotor, exciter, prime mover etc., worked together to generate output and also to show the precautionary measures when there is fault in transformer. At the end, Dr. Sudhir Sharma (Head – EE) encouraged all the participants with his kind words. He appreciated the efforts done by the department of Electrical Engineering and motivated the students to participate more in future.
