में पढ़ रहा है।




ममता ठाकुर बच्चों को पढ़ाते हुए।






- 1. Safety and Security: Protected Campus: The college campus is fully protected by wall compound around the campus trespassers are not allowed without permission.

She has successfully built a team of 110 employees. She is passionate about working on setting up IT villages and curb villages to city migration, unemployment and brain drain. She believes the 'Tangra Business Model' could be replicated and generate lakhs of white-collar jobs in India in IT and various other sectors. She has the target of opening more offices in rural areas of Punjab in the upcoming time

She enlightened the students that if the vision is clear, then funding is not something that can pull your initiative down. She shared that they should have complete focus and consistency towards their ideas to <u>build and run a successful company</u>. She also shared that the budding entrepreneurs will need to create and fine-tune a business plan, assess their finances, complete all the legal paperwork, pick their partners, research apps for startup growth, and choose the best tools and systems to help them get their marketing and sales off the ground.

She also briefed during the session that there are 524 million entrepreneurs globally, and among them, 274 million women entrepreneurs are there in the world. She also highlighted the data that in India, 20.37% of women are MSME owners, accounting for 23.3% of the labour force. In addition, there are 432 million working-age women in India, and 13.5 - 15.7 million women own business that provides direct employment to 22 - 27 million people.

Dr Manoj Kumar, Principal, DAVIET, lauded the plans of Mandeep Kaur Tangra for rural Punjab. He emphasized that government policies need to focus on Rural India, creating an ecosystem for smart villages where 70% of our population lives, rather than creating Smart Cities. The efforts of Mandeep to

The college has Rain Water Harvesting (RWH) near the Institute Guest House adjoining Material Sciences Block. Rainwater infiltration is the major aspect of the rainwater harvesting system constructed in our institute. It is also playing an important role in storm water management and in the replenishment of the groundwater levels. Rainwater harvesting has been practiced for over 4,000 years throughout the world, traditionally in arid and semi-arid areas, and has provided drinking water, domestic water and water for livestock and small irrigation. Today, rainwater harvesting has gained much on significance as a modern, watersaving and simple technology.

01 RWH recharge pit/wells have been laid in the campus to ensure the proper percolation of rainwater to recharge and replenish the ground water. Large Open Green areas are also available at the front and backside (Sports complex) of the institute and within boundary walls of 3 hostels supporting the rapid percolation of rain water and recharge of groundwater table

He shared that recent studies show that 88% of heroin addicts in India are in the age group of 14-25 years. He stated that there is a need of raising the level of consciousness of the self through proper education so that the menace can be tackled head-on.

Dr Sanjeev Lochan Bakshi, Senior Resident (Psychiatrist), Civil Hospital Phagwara was the Key Note Speaker. She shared that 190 million people have attempted drugs worldwide. She elaborated that drug addiction implies physical dependence upon a drug including the development of tolerance and withdrawal. If the addict is not allowed to take the drug he suffers from painful and uncontrollable convulsions, vomiting, depression and various other maladies. She elaborated that the desire to experiment and to have a thrill are the prime reasons for drug abuse. She listed four major drugs in Punjab namely Opium, Alcohol, Tobacco and Cannabis. She also shared that 50 % of urban heroin addicts come from a single-parent families. She educated the students that drug abuse leads to Psychotic Disorder, Mood Disorder, Anxiety Disorder and Amnestic Disorder which can affect the life of an individual a lot.

Mr Ashok Kumar, Assistant Commissioner of Police Jalandhar was the chief Guest. He stated that the future of the nation is bright because of the dynamic and exuberant youth. He also cautioned that the young need to be disciplined and dedicated to realise their dreams and stay away from drugs.
