POLICY DOCUMENTS OF THE **VARIOUS SCHEMES**

DAV Institute Of Engineering & Technology, Jalandhar

The Scholarship/Freeship Programme:

DAV Institute Of Engineering & Technology, Jalandhar has a robust Free ship/Scholarship program aimed at providing financial assistance to the needy students for all the academic years of their study.

1. Tuition Fee Waiver Scheme:

5% seats of the sanctioned intake of each course are reserved for Tuition Fee Waiver Scheme in each department as per IKGPTU norms through university counseling. The seats are super numery to the sanctioned seats.

2. Prime Minister's Special Scholarship Scheme (PMSSS) J&K:

An expert Group was constituted by Prime Minister on 18th August, 2010 in the context of enhancing employment opportunities among youths of Jammu & Kashmir and to formulate job plan involving public and private sectors. Every year fresh scholarships were given to J&K Students to pursue undergraduate studies outside the State of Jammu and Kashmir for improving their skills by providing access to education. Scheme was started in 2011 and modified from time to time to make the Scheme student friendly. 10 students are admitted every year under the scheme.

3. Financial Assistance to financially weak students by Institute:

Numbers of applications are received from the students every year for the grant of fee concession. The applications are scrutinized by the Committee constituted at the institute level for the purpose and concessions are granted accordingly keeping in view the academic performance/financial health of the family.

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Post Matric Scholarship (Punjab):

Post Matric Scholarships for SC Students, Punjab is an initiative for SC students of Class 11 up to post doctoral levels. This scholarship aims to provide financial assistance to Scheduled Caste students studying at the post matriculation or post-secondary stage so that they can complete their higher education.

Faculty/Staff ward Fee waiver scheme: 5.

DAVIET has instituted the following scholarships and fee waiver for its employees, spouse and wards studying in various programs at DAVIET as per the details herein under:

(1) Employee:

- Eligibility: Regular employees with a minimum of 3-year service. a). 100% tuition fee waiver to the employees for UG and PG programmes.
- Retirement: If an employee retires from service, benefits of fee b). waiver will continue for the entire period of the duration of the programme even after retirement. This is applicable only for those who have been admitted before their retirement.
- Continuation of fee waiver to next higher degree: Benefit of the fee waiver will continue to be extended to the employee for next degree; if they successfully complete the previous degree.
- (d). Application for fee waiver would not be treated as an application for employment.
- (e). The grant of fee waiver will not automatically entitle a candidate for leave etc. The employee will have to apply separately for leave, which will be considered as per the leave policy of the Institute.

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- (2) Spouse and Wards:
- a). Eligibility: Regular employees with a minimum of 3-year service.
- b) Scholarship equivalent to 100% of the tuition fee for spouse & wards for UG & PG programmes.
- Institute will award such scholarship to the spouse & two children of c) the employee. Fee waiver will be given to a maximum of two wards admitted under DAVIET Employees quota. Further, the Institute will seek to fill first the seats available under the DAVIET employee quota and only in case number of candidates eligible under DAVIET employees quota exceeds the number of seats available under this quota for a particular branch, then the students topping the merit may be shifted to the open seats provided they get the same or better branch as per their merit. In such eventuality, students shifted in the general merit will be entitled to Scholarship as applicable to students admitted under Employee Wards quota. (Example: If 10 students envisage interest in Computer Engineering and there are only 8 seats under the quota then in that case only, two candidates may be shifted to open merit provided they get the same or better branch in open seats on the basis of their merit. If these two toppers do not get the same or better seat in open merit, then the last two candidates will have to choose branches other than Computer Engineering available under quota).
 - d) This will be equal to tuition fee on a semester basis of programs offered by DAVIET.
 - Retirement: If an employee retires from service, benefits of fee waiver will continue for the entire period of the duration of the programme even after retirement. This is applicable only for those who have been admitted before their retirement.

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Death while in harness: While studying at DAVIET, if the employee 4). dies while in harness, the scholarship shall continue for the remaining normal duration of program.

Bihar Students Credit Card Scheme. 6.

Bihar Students Credit Card Scheme is a loan scheme that helps students who have passed their 12th standard exam to realize the dream of higher education. The government initiative aims to bridge the gap between gross enrollment ration in Bihar and other parts of the country by ensuring that students do not stop their studies because of the lack of funds.

Bihar State scholarship Scheme (PMSP): 7.

- The students of Bihar state belonging to SC/ST/BC/EBC can apply for availing the facility to Bihar Government for perusing the higher education. The students studying at the post-matriculation level (class 11 to post graduation level) can apply for this scholarship.
- They must have passed the last qualifying examination.
- The annual income of the family should be less than INR 2.50 Lakh.
- They must not be in receipt of any other scholarship.

Pragati Scheme for female students: 8.

Pragati is a scheme of AICTE aimed at providing assistance for Advancement of Girls participation in Technical Education. Education is one of the most important means of empowering women with the knowledge, skill and self-confidence necessary to participate fully in the development process. This is an attempt to give every young Woman the opportunity to further her education and prepare for a successful future by "Empowering Women Through Technical Education".

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Salient Features of the Scheme:

Number of scholarships per annum: 4000

'One Girl' per family and it can be extended for Two Girl Child per family where the family income is less than Rs. 8 Lakh /annum (In case of married girl child, the income of parents/ in laws whichever is higher is to be considered).

The candidates will be selected on Merit at the qualifying examination to pursue technical education from amongst such candidates. The candidates should have been admitted to 1st year of the Degree or Diploma programme in any of the AICTE approved institute during the current Academic Year through centralized admission process of the State/ Centre Government.

Amount of scholarship: Tuition Fee of Rs. 30000/- or at actual, whichever is less and Rs.2000/- per month for 10 months as incidentals each year.

In case of candidates availing Tuition fee waiver/reimbursement, and amount of Rs. 30000/- may be reimbursed to the candidates selected for this scheme by the way of reimbursement for

- a) Purchase of books,
- b) Purchase of equipments, software
- c) Purchase of Laptops.
- d) Purchase of Desktops
- e) Purchase of Vehicle
- f) Fees paid towards competitive examination application forms/exam fees for all examinations related to higher education / employment.

Reservation-15% for SC, 7.5% ST and 27% for OBC candidate/applicant.

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9. Scholarship for minorities:

The Prime Minister's New 15 Point Programme for the Welfare of Minorities was announced in June, 2006. It provides scholarship scheme for meritorious students from minority communities students to enable them to pursue professional and technical courses.

ELIGIBILITY:

Scholarship will be awarded to the students who have secured not less than 50% marks or equivalent grade in the previous final examination and the annual income of whose parents/guardians from all sources does not exceed Rs.2.00 lakh. Muslims, Sikhs, Christians, Buddhists, Jain and Zoroastrians (Parsis) who have been notified as minority communities under Section 2 (c) of the National Commission for Minorities Act, 1992 are eligible to apply.

10. Central Sector Scheme of Scholarship:

The scheme aims to provide financial assistance to meritorious students from low income families to meet a part of their day to day expenses while pursuing higher studies. Central Sector Scheme of Scholarship for College and University Students 2021-22 is an initiative for Class 12 passed students who are studying in college/university. The scholarship aims to support meritorious students from financially weaker sections by providing them financial assistance for their day-to-day expenses incurred while pursuing higher studies.

Eligibility

To be eligible, an applicant must:

- Be above the 80th percentile of successful candidates in the relevant stream in Class 12 or equivalent of respective state examination boards.
- Be pursuing a regular course such as Medical and Engineering in a college/institution recognized by the AICTE, Dental Council of India

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(DCI), Medical Council of India (MCI), and other respective regulatory authorities

Have annual family income not more than INR 8 lakh from all sources

Not be in receipt of any other scholarship

11. Scholarship Scheme for the wards of Central Armed Police Forces, Assam Rifles & State Police Personnel:

Prime Minister's Scholarship Scheme (PMSS) under the aegis of the National Defense Fund, was introduced from the academic year 2006-07 to encourage higher technical & professional education for the dependent wards & widows of Central Armed Police Forces & Assam Rifles (CAPFs & AR) Personnel. From the academic session 2020-21, this scheme has further been extended for the dependent wards of State Police Personnel who are martyred during Terror/Naxal attacks.

Eligibility:

- A) For CAPFs & Assam Rifles: I) Wards/widows of deceased CAPFs & AR personnel died in harness/election duty, wards of personnel disabled due to causes attributable to Government service and Wards of Ex-CAPFs & AR personnel in receipt of Gallantry Awards.
- II) Wards/widows of retired and serving CAPFs & AR Personnel. (Personnel below Officer Rank) III) Pursuing first professional degree programme in the field of Engineering, Medicine, Dental, Veterinary, BBA, BCA, B. Pharma, B.SC (Nursing, Agriculture, etc.), MBA and MCA etc. in accordance with the guidelines as mentioned in Para- 8 (B).
- IV) Having minimum 60% marks in Minimum Entry Qualification (MEQ) i.e. 10+2/Diploma/Graduation or equivalent in case of new applicant. Or For applicants applying under renewal category, it is mandatory to pass the each

V) A grace period of one year only for cases, where there is a delay on part of candidate for submission of application for renewal of scholarship may be entertained.

Duration of Scholarship:

Up to five years (depending upon the duration of the course being pursued by the applicant and as approved by the respective regulatory body).

- a). Amount of Scholarship I. Rs. 3000/-per month for girls. To be paid annually after selection. II. Rs. 2500/- per month for boys @ Rs 36,000/-to each girl & Rs 30,000/- to each boy
- b). Letter from Hon'ble Prime Minister All applicants selected under new category will be given personal letters from Hon'ble Prime Minister in appropriate language.
- c). Guidelines for the Applicant Applying online under PMSS Before applying, the applicants should read the instructions/guidelines carefully as mentioned below:- A) Minimum Entry Qualification (MEQ): For being eligible for the scholarship under PMSS, an applicant should have secured minimum 60% marks in MEQ i.e. 10+2 / Diploma / Graduation as the case may be. MEQ for entry to various professional courses differs. For example MEQ for MBBS is 10+2 whereas for BE/B.Tech it is 10+2/Diploma. It is graduation for B.Ed. and MBA. Note: Wards admitted in 2nd year of technical/professional Bachelor Degree Course (BE/B. Tech etc) through lateral entry after completion of Diploma courses are eligible for PMSS. In case of applicant passed XII exam from CBSE, marks obtained in best of five subjects out of 500 will be considered for calculating the percentage of marks in MEQ.

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B) For State Police Forces:

Dependent wards of State Police Personnel who are martyred during Terror/ Naxal attacks are eligible under this category subject to the following:-

- Pursuing first professional degree programme in the field of Engineering, Medicine, Dental, Veterinary, BBA, BCA, B. Pharma, B.SC (Nursing, Agriculture, etc.), MBA and MCA etc. in accordance with the guidelines as mentioned in Para- 8 (B).
- II) Having minimum 60% marks in Minimum Entry Qualification (MEQ) i.e. 10+2/Diploma/Graduation or equivalent in case of new applicant. Or For applicants applying under renewal category, it is mandatory to pass the each subsequent academic year of the professional courses being pursued by them with minimum 50% marks.
- III) A grace period of one year only for cases, where there is a delay on part of candidate for submission of application for renewal of scholarship may be entertained.

12. Post Matric Scholarship for OBC students of Himachal Pardesh:

The objective of the scheme is to provide financial assistance to the OBC students studying at post matriculation or post secondary stage to enable them to complete the education. Centrally Sponsored Post Matric Scholarship Scheme for OBC Students, Himachal Pradesh 2021 is an initiative for the students of OBC communities who are studying at the post-matric and post-secondary level. The selected candidates will get variable benefits under this scheme.

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Eligibility:

Students fulfilling the following criteria can apply:

- The student must be studying at a post-matric or a post-secondary level.
- The student must belong to the OBC community.
- The student must be a permanent resident/domicile of Himachal Pradesh.
- The annual family income should not be more than INR 1.5 lakh per annum.

Benefits

The students will get the following awards:

- Maintenance allowance (up to INR 750 per month for hostellers and up to INR 350 per month for day scholars)
- Reimbursement of compulsory non-refundable fees
- Study tour charges of up to INR 900 per annum
- Thesis typing and printing charges of up to INR 1,000
- Additional allowances of up to INR 175 per month for OBC students with disabilities

GUIDELINES

CENTRAL SECTOR SCHEME OF SCHOLARSHIP FOR COLLEGE AND UNIVERSITY STUDENTS

AUGUST, 2018

7. RATE OF SCHOLARSHIPS:

The rate of scholarship is Rs.10000/- per annum at Graduation level for first three years of College and University courses and Rs.20000/- per annum at Post-Graduation level. Students pursuing professional courses, in case, where the duration of course is five (5) years/Integrated course would get Rs.20000/- per annum in the 4th and 5th year. However, students pursuing technical courses such as B.Tech., B.Engg would get scholarship up to graduation level.

8. PARENTAL INCOME CEILING:

The parental/family income ceiling is Rs. 8 lakh per annum for all categories under the scheme and would be applicable from the Academic Session 2018-19. Income certificate would be required for the fresh applicants only.

9. DURATION OF SCHOLARSHIPS AND ITS RENEWAL

A student will be eligible for the scholarship for a total duration not exceeding 5 years. A scholarship under the scheme is renewable on year to year basis up to Post Graduate level in the same stream (except for the students pursuing technical courses leading to degree at graduation level).

If a scholar is unable to appear in the annual examination owing to illness and or on account of any unforeseen event, the award may be renewed for the next academic year on submission of medical certificate and other proof to satisfy the Head of the Institution who will certify that the student would have passed with required percentage of marks or equivalent Grade Point Average, had he/she appeared in the examination.

A scholar would be allowed to continue/renew his/her scholarship if, he/she changes the course of study to a stream not offered by his school Board in Class XII (e.g. Law, Fashion Technology, etc.). Students changing their college/institute of study would be allowed to continue/renew the scholarship provided the course of study and the institution is recognized.

10. For receiving scholarship benefit under Central Sector Scheme of Scholarship for College and University Students, an individual shall furnish proof of possession of Aadhaar or undergo Aadhaar authentication. Till the time Aadhaar is assigned to the individual, following alternative identifiers can be used:-

III. CONDITIONS OF ELIGIBILITY

The scholarships will be open to Indian nationals belonging to OBCs, as notified by the Central Govt./State Govt./ UT Admn.;

These scholarships will be given for the study of all recognized post-matriculation or post-secondary courses pursued in recognized institutions as specified in para

iii. Only those candidates who belong to OBCs so specified in relation to the State/UT to which the applicant actually belongs, i.e. permanently settled and who have passed the Matriculation or Higher secondary or any higher examination of a recognized University or Board of Secondary Education will be eligible.

Candidates who, after passing one stage of education, are studying in the same stage of education in different subject e.g. I. Sc. after I.A or B.Com. after B.A. or

M.A. in a subject after M.A in another subject will not be eligible.

Students who, after having completed their educational career in one professional

line, e.g., LLB after B.T/B. Ed will not be eligible.

Students studying in XI Class of the Higher Secondary School courses or the XII class of the Multipurpose High School will not be eligible for it being a continuous school course. However, in cases, where tenth class examination of such courses is treated as equivalent to Matriculation and students who after passing tenth class join other courses, such students will be treated as post-matric students and will be eligible for the award of scholarships.

Students pursuing Post-graduate courses in medicine will be eligible only if they

are not allowed to practice during the period of their course.

Students who after failing or passing the Under Graduate/Post-Graduate VIII. examinations in Arts/Science/Commerce join any recognized professional in Technical certificate/diploma/degree courses will be awarded scholarships it otherwise eligible. No subsequent failure will be condoned except for courses in Group 'A' and no further change in the course will be allowed thereafter.

Students who pursue their studies through correspondence courses will be eligible towards reimbursement of non-refundable fee. The term correspondence includes distant and continuing education. Besides reimbursement of non-refundable fee, such students will also be eligible for an annual allowance of Rs. 900/- for essential/prescribed books, as applicable.

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SCHEME OF 'MERIT CUM MEANS BASED SCHOLARSHIP' FOR STUDENTS BELONGING TO THE MINORITY COMMUNITIES

OBJECTIVE

The objective of the Scheme is to provide financial assistance to the poor and meritorious students belonging to minority communities to enable them to pursue professional and technical courses.

2. SCOPE

The scholarship is to be awarded for studies in India in a Government or private institution, selected and notified in a transparent manner by the State Government/Union Territory Administration concerned. It will cover technical and professional courses at undergraduate and post graduate level. A list of courses are at Appendix-E.

3. ELIGIBILITY

Scholarship will be awarded to the students who have secured not less than 50% marks or equivalent grade in the previous final examination and the annual income of whose parents/guardians from all sources does not exceed Rs.2.50 lakh.

4. DISTRIBUTION

Muslims, Sikhs, Christians, Buddhists, Jain and Zoroastrians (Parsis) have been notified as minority communities under Section 2 (c) of the National Commission for Minorities Act, 1992. A total of 60,000 scholarships are targeted to be distributed as 'Fresh' Scholarships, besides, Renewal scholarships. The distribution of scholarship among the States/Union Territories will be made on the basis of population of minorities in the States/Union Territories as per Census 2001 for 2017-18 and as per the population of minorities in the States/Union Territories of Census 2011 for 2018-19 and 2019-20 (as per Appendices- A & B).

EARMARKING

- i) 30% scholarship is earmarked for girls students of each minority community in a State/UT which is transferable to male students of that community in case of non-availability of female students in that community in the concerned State/UT. 30% is the floor and not the ceiling for eligible girl students.
- ii) If the physical target of scholarship for a particular minority community in a state/UT is not utilized, it will be distributed among the same minority community in other States/UTs strictly in accordance with merit and without disturbing the national ratio. Any unutilized community quota shall be distributed amongst other communities again in accordance with merit and without affecting the overall national quota.
- iii) A student residing in a particular State/UT will be entitled for scholarship under the quota of that State/UT only irrespective of his/her place of study.

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6. SELECTION PROCEDURE

- (i) Fresh The number of scholarship has been fixed State/UT-wise on the basis of Community-wise minority population of the States/UTs as per Census 2001 (2017-18) & 2011 (2018-20). Within the State-wise allocations, the applications from Listed Institutions will be exhausted first in merit list. In case number of such students is more than the State/Community-wise quota, normal merit list criteria shall be followed. Other verified applicant/student will be selected in the merit list, thereafter, on merit basis i.e. Percentage/marks of last academic course/board (higher secondary / graduation) exam. In case of similar marks, income will be taken as deciding factor.
- (ii) Renewal There is no merit list generation for renewal cases. Renewal applicant will get the scholarship if one has obtained 50% in his/her previous year's examinations (or in each semester/trimester of previous year's) their application is approved by State Governments/UTs.

DURATION

Scholarship will be provided for the entire academic year/course. Similarly, the maintenance allowance will be given as fixed lump sum amount for an academic year (Rs. 10,000/- for Hosteller and Rs. 5,000/- for Day Scholar).

RATE OF SCHOLARSHIP

The details of the scheme interventions for the three years viz.2017-18 to 2019-20 are as under:

9. LIST OF INSTITUTES FOR FULL COURSE FEE REIMBURSEMENT

There is a list of 85 Reputed Premier Institutes, covered under the scheme, for which a student is eligible for full Course Fee reimbursement as scholarship during an academic year. A list of such Institutes is at Appendix – C.

10. CONDITIONS FOR SCHOLARSHIP

- (i) Students who get admission to a college to pursue technical/professional courses, on the basis of a competitive examination will be eligible for the scholarship.
- (ii) Financial assistance will be given to pursue graduate level or post graduate level technical and professional courses from a recognized institution Admission and Course fee and Maintenance allowance for the year of scholarship will be

SCHEME OF 'POST-MATRIC SCHOLARSHIP' FOR STUDENTS BELONGING TO THE MINORITY COMMUNITIES

1. BACKGROUND

The Prime Minister's New 15 Point Programme for the Welfare of Minorities was announced in June, 2006. It provides that a post-matric scholarship scheme for meritorious students from minority communities would be implemented.

2. OBJECTIVE

The objective of the scheme is to award scholarships to meritorious students belonging to economically weaker sections of minority community so as to provide them better opportunities for higher education, increase their rate of attainment in higher education and enhance their employability.

3. SCOPE

The scholarship is to be awarded for studies in India in a government or private higher secondary school/college/university, including such residential institutes of the Government and eligible private institutes selected and notified in a transparent manner by the State Government/Union Territory Administration concerned. It will also cover technical and vocational courses in Industrial Training Institutes/ Industrial Training Centres affiliated with the National Council for Vocational Training (NCVT) of classes XI and XII level including Polytechnics and other courses (any course of less than one year duration is not covered under this scheme; Certificate courses are also not covered).

4. ELIGIBILITY

Scholarship will be awarded to the students who have secured not less than 50% marks or equivalent grade in the previous final examination and the annual income of whose parents/guardians from all sources does not exceed Rs.2.00 lakh.

DISTRIBUTION

Muslims, Sikhs, Christians, Buddhists, Jain and Zoroastrians (Parsis) have been notified as minority communities under Section 2 (c) of the National Commission for Minorities Act, 1992. A total of five (05) lakh scholarships are targeted to be distributed as 'Fresh' Scholarships, besides, Renewal scholarships. The distribution of scholarship among the States/Union Territories will be made on the basis of population of minorities in the States/Union Territories as per Census 2001 for 2017-18 and as per the population of minorities in the States/Union Territories of Census 2011 for 2018-19 and 2019-20 (as per Appendices- A & B).

EARMARKING

- 30% scholarship is earmarked for girls students of each minority community in a State/UT which is transferable to male students of that community in case of non-availability of female students in that community in the concerned State/UT.
 30% is the floor and not the ceiling for eligible girl students.
- ii) If the physical target of scholarship for a particular minority community in a state/UT is not utilized, it will be distributed among the same minority

community in other States/UTs strictly in accordance with merit and without disturbing the national ratio. Any unutilized community quota shall be distributed amongst other communities again in accordance with merit and without affecting the overall national quota.

iii) A student residing in a particular State/UT will be entitled for scholarship under the quota of that State/UT only irrespective of his/her place of study.

7. SELECTION PROCEDURE

Fresh - As the number of scholarships for minorities available in a year is fixed and limited, it is necessary to lay down preference for selection. Inter-se selection weightage is to be given to poverty rather than marks (the applicant is required to submit an income certificate as per para-11(ii)). In case of same income, merit shall be generated from 'Date of Birth' criteria of applicant (senior is preferred).

Renewal – There is no merit list generation for renewal cases. Renewal applicant will get the scholarship if one has obtained 50% in his/her previous year's examinations (at the same institute and in same course) and his/her application is verified by all authorities (as designated by Ministry of Minority Affairs) and approved by State Governments/UTs.

DURATION

The scholarships shall be provided for the entire course of the academic year. Maintenance allowance will be given as fixed lump sum amount in an academic year (as per para-9 below) for 2017-18 to 2019-20.

RATES OF SCHOLARSHIP

Actual financial assistance will be provided for admission & course /tuition fee and maintenance allowance as given below subject to a maximum ceiling indicated against item concerned for 2017-20. The details of the scheme interventions for 2017-18 to 2019-20 are as under:

(who are not entailing the pay benefits of Assistant Commandant and drawing the Salary of Inspectors) are eligible for granting PMS under category "F" & "G" also.

III) This scholarship is admissible for only two children per family and should be ensured by the beneficiaries as well as by the respective CAPF & AR.

IV) The applicants irrespective of his /her marital status is eligible for PMSS.

5. <u>Duration of Scholarship</u>

Upto five years (depending upon the duration of the course being pursued by the applicant and as approved by the respective regulatory body).

6. Amount of Scholarship

I. Rs. 3000/-per month for girls.

To be paid annually after selection.

Rs 36000/- to each girl& Rs 30000/to each boy

II. Rs. 2500/- per month for boys

7. Letter from Hon'ble Prime Minister

All applicants selected under new category will be given personal letters from Hon'ble Prime Minister in appropriate language.

8. Guidelines for the Applicant Applying online under PMSS

Before applying, the applicants viould read the instructions/guidelines carefully as mentioned below:-

A) Minimum Entry Qualification (MEQ):

For being eligible for the scholarship under PMSS, an applicant should have secured minimum 60% marks in MEQ i.e. 10+2/ Diploma/ Graduation as the case may be. MEQ for entry to various professional course differs. For example MEQ for MBBS is 10+2 whereas for BE/B. Tech it is 10+2/Diploma. It is graduation for B. Ed and MBA.

Note: -

Wards admitted in 2nd year of technical/professional Bachelor Degree Course (BE/B.Tech etc) through lateral entry after completion of Diploma courses are eligible for PMSS.


 In case of applicant passed XII exam from CBSE, marks obtained in best of five subjects out of 500 will be considered for calculating the percentage of marks in MEQ.

B) Courses applicable under PMSS:

- Only First professional degree courses like BE, B Tech, BDS, MBBS, B.Ed., BBA, BCA, B Pharma, B.Sc (Nursing, Agriculture, etc.) duly recognized by the respective Government Regulatory Bodies, such as All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), Medical Council of India (MCI), University Grant Commission (UGC).
- II) Details of professional degree courses applicable for PMSS are mentioned at Appendix- I.

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GUIDELINES FOR AICTE – PRAGATI SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME FOR GIRL STUDENTS (DEGREE)

1.0 OBJECTIVE OF THE SCHEME:

Scheme being implemented by AICTE aimed at providing assistance for advancement of Girls pursuing technical education. Education is one of the most important means of empowering women with the knowledge, skill and self-confidence necessary to participate fully in the development process. This is an attempt to give young women the opportunity to further her education and prepare for a successful future by "Empowering Women through Technical Education".

2.0 ELIGIBILITY FOR SCHOLARSHIP:

1) The girl candidate should be admitted to First year of Degree level course

OR

Second year of Degree level course through lateral entry in any of the AICTE approved Institution of respective year.

2) Maximum two girl child per family are eligible.

(3) Family income from all sources should not be more than Rs. 8 lakh per annum during the current financial year. A valid income certificate issued by State/ UT Government need to be enclosed.

3.0 NUMBER OF SCHOLARSHIPS:

- A total of 5,000 scholarships are earmarked per annum under this scheme for pursuing
 First year of Degree level course OR Second year of Degree level course through
 lateral entry in any of the AICTE approved Institutions. The number of scholarships
 are transferred into AICTE PRAGATI SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME FOR GIRL
 STUDENTS (DIPLOMA), if sufficient number of online applications are not
 received.
- 2) State/Union Territory wise distribution of 5,000 scholarships is as per Annexure A.
- 3) In addition to 5,000 scholarships at point number 2, all eligible girls who submit online scholarship form, from following 13 Union Territories and North Eastern States i.e. Andaman and Nicobar Islands (UT), Jammu and Kashmir (UT), Ladakh (UT), Dadra and Nagar Haveli & Daman and Diu (UT), Lakshadweep (UT), Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, Sikkim & Tripura will be given scholarship by AICTE.

4.0 AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP:

 Rs. 50,000/- per annum for every year of study i.e. maximum 4 years for first year admitted students and maximum 3 years for second year admitted students through lateral entry as lump sum amount towards payment of college fee, purchase of
